Toluca Baseball is a league where boys and girls can have fun and learn to play the game. By being part of a Toluca team, players, coaches and parents all agree to strive toward fostering a positive environment for all to enjoy. As such, all Toluca Baseball participants agree to be held accountable to uphold our Codes of Conduct.

- I will show support through positive cheering for my child's team and demonstrate respect for members of each team, the coaches, umpires and the league's volunteers.
- I will let the coaches do their jobs and refrain from interfering with their instructions and communications to their players before, during and after all games and practices.
- I will recognize that baseball is a game through which Toluca Baseball league's intent is to build character, foster good sportsmanship and teach boys and girls the fundamentals of baseball with an ultimate goal of having fun.
- I will demonstrate good parenting by refraining from inappropriate language and behavior at all games and practices.
- I will respect the City of Los Angeles's strong ordinances against smoking and consuming alcohol in and near all city parks.
- I will help Toluca Baseball keep its facilities clean by taking responsibility for my family's garbage including seeds and gum, which are discouraged from being consumed on our fields and in the dugouts.
- I will respect our residential neighbors' quality of life by refraining from excessive noise such as noisemakers in the stands and loud noises from my car.
- I will keep our neighborhoods safe by obeying all traffic and parking laws—as well as common courtesies about blocking driveways, excessive speed, yielding to pedestrians, honking horns and playing loud music.
- I will respect parking spaces reserved for Dept. of Recreation & Parks staff, disabled, and emergency personnel by parking only in designated parking spaces at all times.
- I will take responsibility for my guests invited to enjoy Toluca Baseball games and ensure that they understand and respect this code of conduct.
- I am clear about Toluca Baseball's rules and obligations to suspend and consider additional disciplinary actions against any parent, player or coach that has been ejected from a game.
